CODE OF CONDUCT – Team Official

As a Team Official:


- · Abide by the Department's Code of Conduct at all times.
- Adhere to appropriate mandatory reporting requirements.
- Ensure that your behaviour at all times, whether at or away from the playing venue, does not bring the name of 'school sport' into disrepute.
- Show respect and behave in a manner that respects the rights of all others regardless of the medium of communication used, e.g. verbal, physical, digital media such as Twitter, Facebook, email and texts.
- Provide a safe and supportive sporting and learning environment.
- Initiate and maintain constructive communication and relationships with students and parents/carers.
- Promote the skills of responsible self-management.
- Communicate high expectations for individual achievement and behaviour.
- Ensure consistency and fairness in implementing the school sport behaviour codes.
- Avoid over-playing the talented players. All players need and deserve equitable time.
- Develop team respect for the ability of opponents as well as for the judgment of officials and opposing coaches.
- Compliment participants on their efforts.
- Condemn unsporting behaviours.
- . Ensure that your behaviour is consistent with the principles of good sporting behaviour.
- · Refrain from criticism of, or reaction to, the umpires/referee's judgment and decision.
- · Maintain a standard of dress appropriate to the presentation of the team.
- Refrain from over-zealous coaching from the side-line.
- Smoking, drinking of alcoholic beverages or the use of any illegal substances is strictly forbidden while in the direct supervision of students.

Breach of the Code by Team Officials

Queensland School Sport (QSS) and event organisers may deal immediately with any breaches of this code by warning offenders about their conduct, asking offenders to leave venues, and calling police to intervene where necessary. The Department, through Queensland School Sport (QSS), is responsible for imposing any longer term consequences such as written warnings, or barring attendance at future events for a period or indefinitely. This may include QSS providing a report to your school principal or immediate supervisor, and you may be subject to discipline in accordance with the *Education (General Provisions) Act 2006* (EGPA). Staff will be afforded natural justice in respect of breaches of this code and for any discipline under the EGPA.

STUDENT PROTECTION

Regardless of your role with the Northern Team, at all times you are an educator. If during the course of your duties you suspect that one of the players in your team is at risk of harm you **MUST** follow the flow chart below **IMMEDIATELY**.

NORTHERN REGION SCHOOL SPORT: STUDENT PROTECTION GUIDELINES



The immediate safety of a student is the foremost consideration. In the case of an emergency or where there is a concern that a child could be at immediate risk of harm, consider what actions may be necessary to protect the child. This could include calling Child Safety or police, or calling 000. Regardless of your role with the Northern Team, at all times you are an educator. If during the course of your duties you suspect that one of the players in your team is at risk of harm you MUST follow the flow chart below IMMIEDIATELY

Form a suspicion

- A Regional team official / Convenor becomes aware or reasonably suspects the sexual abuse or likely sexual abuse of a child under 18yrs old OR
- forms reasonable suspicion that a child is suffering or is at risk of suffering significant harm* and may not have a parent able and willing to protect them
- Regional team official consults with their RSSO or the host RSSO

Consult

- •If you suspect sexual abuse or likely sexual abuse, you must immediately report this to police in writing. If for any reason there could be a delay in providing a written report to police, call Policelink on 131 444 and let them know a report will be progressed in writing ASAP. If this is done, make sure you make notes of this.
- For cases of significant harm, Regional team official or RSSO to consult the online Queensland Child Protection Guide at https://www.communities.qld.gov.au/to determine if a report to Child Safety is required
- •RSSO to consult with the Principal Advisor or Director of Regional Services (DRS)

Commence a Student Protection Report

- Report suspicions of sexual abuse or likely sexual abuse immediately to the QPS (see above) as per Education (General Provisions) Act 2006
- For cases of significant harm, if the threshold for reporting to Child Safety has been met, Regional team official or RSSO commences a Child Protection Report using the Department of Communities, Child Safety and Disablility Services website https://secure.communities.qld.gov.au/cbir/home/ChildSafety
- . If child is experiencing harm, contact Regional Intake Services 1300 704 514 (Townsville)
- RSSO to contact the student's principal

After submitting a report

- Regional team official to continue to monitor and support the student while at the State Championship
- Regional team official to provide all notes to the RSSO for secure storage
- Regional team official / RSSO to collaborate with Child Safety, QPS and other agencies as per the Student Protection Procedure

CONCUSSION

OFFICIAL'S TRAVEL & ACCOMMODATION

TRAVEL

- ➤ ALL Players in Northern teams travel individually to the event, team travel is NO longer an option.
 - Implications for team managers checking travel arrangements have been made, esp. team sports
 - > Start / finish time of event clearly communicated in team comms, and on Team Newsletter
- > Team Officials have approval (paid for by Northern)
 - ➤ Hire car to Cairns / Mackay
 - ➤ All other events fly into Brisbane, collect hire car from airport and drive (25+yrs only)
 - > Forward flights booked for travel day, return flight booked for conclusion of State Championship
 - ➤ Notify Northern School Sport office 2 terms prior to event, if you wish to vary flight.
 - > Refuel hire care upon return submit receipts through ExpenseMe Pro.
 - ➤ Non-Townsville Officials provided with overnight accommodation in Townsville and ½ day TRS upon return.








FIRST STOP — Leading up to Northern Trials

FOR CONVENOR

- For 13 19yrs Trials, if you are the Northern Coach you will also be the Northern Trial Convenor.
- For most 10 12yrs Trials there will be a separate convenor.
- Convenor will be sent Northern Trial CARA document prior to trial
- Compiled and sent out by Northern School Sport Office (you will be sent a draft (4 weeks prior) this is FYI).





- Team / player nominations emailed back to you.
- Please note:
 - Field bookings done by Northern Sports Office
 - FAO bookings done by Northern Sports Office these FAOs familiar with Northern processes
 - Northern Office Staff will be at trial, with Northern Trial Convenor Pack (includes accident/concussion/incident forms)
 - Northern staff will bring paperwork for players selected in Northern team
 - Will also bring promotional material



NORTHERN TRIALS – Absent Competitor

Northern School Sport policy states that students must participate in the Northern Trial to be eligible for selection.

Students can request an exemption from trial. The grounds for exemption:

- 1. Medical (medical certificate must be supplied)
- 2. Competing at higher level sport / another Northern School Sport trial.
- 3. Competing with another QRSS / National team.
- 4. Bereavement or compassionate reasons

Absentee Application for Exemption forms can be obtained from the Northern School Sport Office. Where possible exemption should be sought 24hrs before the trial.






STOP 3 −*Northern Trials* → *State Championships*

TRAINING PROGRAM

- ➤ To adequately prepare for the State Championships Northern teams will require training. It is an expectation that Northern Teams have a minimum of 2 to 3 training sessions.
 - This does not apply to all teams. Some teams (swimming, golf, cross country) have NO training sessions, other teams have upwards of 5 sessions.
- ➤ Within a couple of days of the Northern Trial you will be sent a training overview to complete.
- > Requires Principal's signature.
- ➤ Completion of this advises your Principal of what you are doing. It also provides a level of cover if you were to injure yourself at one of these training sessions.
- ➤ The timing of the training sessions must be inclusive of all players. Please be mindful that you may have players that are travelling. This *may* rule out after school training sessions.
- ➤ Ideally, 2 x training sessions after team levy payment is due (helps with uniform distribution).
- > ALL team officials are to complete this document and return to Northern Sports Office





MANAGER'S WORKBOOK again

- ➤ Have sent workbook to Northern Sport Office (within 48 hours of Northern Trial)
